Wildlife Ecology Camp at Weedon Island Preserve

This summer camp is designed for children with a strong interest in nature. Campers explore the ecology and conservation of Florida's wildlife and wildlands with field biologist and environmental educator George L. Heinrich. A blend of classroom and field sessions includes hands-on activities, presentations, and exploration of the Preserve's rich biodiversity, where campers will practice their nature detective skills.

Dates: Monday – Friday

July 13 – July 17, 2009

Who should attend:

Students entering 2nd – 6th grade in August 2009 that are between the ages of 7-11 are encouraged to attend.

Registration Fee:

\$125/camper/week

Each session is limited to 30 campers and registration is on a first-come basis.

No before or after camp care is available.

Herpetology Camp at Weedon Island Preserve

This week-long nature camp has the inquisitive child in mind. Campers explore the fascinating world of amphibians and reptiles side-by-side with George Heinrich, a professional herpetologist. Through up-close encounters with a variety of animals such as gopher tortoises, frogs, lizards, and snakes, campers learn about amphibian and reptile ecology and conservation.

July 20 – July 24, 2009

Who should attend:

Students entering 2nd – 6th grade in August 2009 that are between the ages of 7-11 are encouraged to attend.

Registration Fee:

\$125/camper/week

Each session is limited to 30 campers and registration is on a first-come basis.

No before or after camp care is available.

How to register:

All payment may be made during normal Center hours (see contact information) by:

- **Check**
 - o Hand-deliver to the Center or send via US Postal Service (see contact information).
 - o Make check payable to **Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners**.
 - o Registration form must accompany payment.
- **Cash**
 - o Cash transactions must be hand-delivered to the Center.
 - o **DO NOT** send cash via the US Postal Service.
 - o Registration form must accompany payment.
- **Visa Credit Card**
 - o Credit card payment may be made by visiting or telephoning the Center (see contact information).
 - o If phoning, immediately fax or e-mail the registration form (see contact information).

NOTE: Camp registration is not confirmed until payment has been received.

Camp reservations are filled via confirmed registrations on a first-come basis.

Cancellation Policy:

All cancellation requests must be received in writing via United States Postal Service, email, or fax (see contact information).

- 100% Refund:** Cancellation postmarked no later than 5:00 pm, Monday, June 22, 2009.
- 50% Refund:** Cancellation postmarked no later than 5:00 pm, Monday, June 29, 2009.
- 0% Refund:** Cancellation postmarked after 5:00 pm, June 29, 2009.
